Carlos Lobo (Guimarães, 1974) is a photographer, musician, researcher and programmer in the field of Photography. Professor at the School of Arts at the Portuguese Catholic University, he is a researcher at CITAR – Center for Research in Science and Technology of the Arts. PhD in Science and Technology of Arts from the Portuguese Catholic University. Since 2018, he has been the coordinator of the Photography Masters at Escola das Artes. He is also a founding member and programmer of CAAA (Center for Art and Architecture Affairs) and editor of LEBOP, a publisher specializing in photography books. He has published several monographs and his work is represented in numerous prestigious national and international photography collections. As a director, he developed several music videos for the band EVOLS, of which he is a founding member. From his filmography, there is also the experimental short A SHIMMER OF HAPPINESS, in homage to director Jonas Mekas. Aos Dezesseis was his first fiction short film, for which he was the writer and director.
